



## EVENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Each spectator taking part in the event is obliged to get acquainted with the rules and regulations set forward by the event Organiser. The following rules concern the event as well as all the spectators taking part in it.
2. The Organiser of the FIS Ski Jumping Grand Prix event is Śląsko-Beskidzki Związek Narciarski, ul. Wyzwolenia 67, 43-460 Wisła.
3. The ticket sale will be carried out on the [www.kupbilet.pl](http://www.kupbilet.pl) website and at the Wiślańskie Centrum Kultury, in Hoffa square 3 in Wisła.
4. Purchasing tickets to the mentioned event and entering the event venue, spectators agree and allow the following:
  - a) free use of own image fixed during the event for promotion and marketing purposes of the Organiser
  - b) presence in an area of increased noise exposition, that might in some cases lead to hearing impairments
  - c) presence in a crowded area, together with any inconveniences this may entail
5. Damaged tickets, without a valid control coupon, or where the bar code has been impaired loses its validity, and as such cannot be refunded nor exchanged.
6. Under no circumstances ticket duplicates shall be issued.
7. The event Organiser has a right to:
  - a) refuse entry to valid ticket holders in justified cases of event safety threat
  - b) refuse the right to record the event in any way using camcorders, cameras, etc. including the right to forbid any of these appliances being carried into the event venue
  - c) forbid any of the following being carried into the event venue – bottles with liquids, poles, trumpets, etc.
  - d) change sector of the ticket holder despite its being designated to a given area
  - e) change the event programme, its time and place, its cancellation without any additional compensation
8. Tickets once purchased can only be refunded in case of event cancellation by the Organiser – on basis of valid invoice or receipt received on purchase. Such refunds will be realised in the week after the planned event, detailed information will be provided on the [www.wisla.pl](http://www.wisla.pl) website.
9. Point 8 does not apply to the following cases of event cancellation- when only a part of the event has been cancelled, when the event has been cancelled directly before the scheduled start time due to bad weather conditions (decision by the Jury of the competition).
10. Independently of the above mentioned rules and regulations, each spectator taking part in the event is obliged to obey and follow rules set forward in relevant act provisions on safety of mass events.
11. Anyone purchasing tickets to the mentioned event automatically accept the above mentioned rules and regulations.
12. The ticket sellers cannot be held responsible for any of the Organiser's activities concerning the event.
13. Based on the exerts from act on safety of mass events (Dz. U. Nr 106 z 1997r. Poz. 680 z późn. zm.):
  - a) art. 14 ust. 2. - any kinds of guns or weapons, dangerous objects (tools, etc.), explosives, fireworks, combustibles, alcoholic drinks, or any kinds of drugs are not allowed in the event venue.
  - b) art. 16 ust. 1. - security personnel is entitled to check individuals identity, as well as perform security check-ups of clothing, luggage, demand to leave the event venue, use of physical force whenever required, call for police assistance whenever required, arresting of violators
  - c) art. 21 ust. 2. - anyone refusing to follow security personnel instructions is a subject to fine.
